Dr. Shauna Devine is an historian of Civil War and American medicine. Devine has authored many articles on the Civil War medical history and won awards for her work including the H.N. Devine is also the author of *“Learning from the Wounded: The Civil War and the Rise of American Medical Science”* (University of North Carolina Press, 2014), which examines the development of scientific medicine during the American Civil War, and the impact of the War’s events on American medicine.
